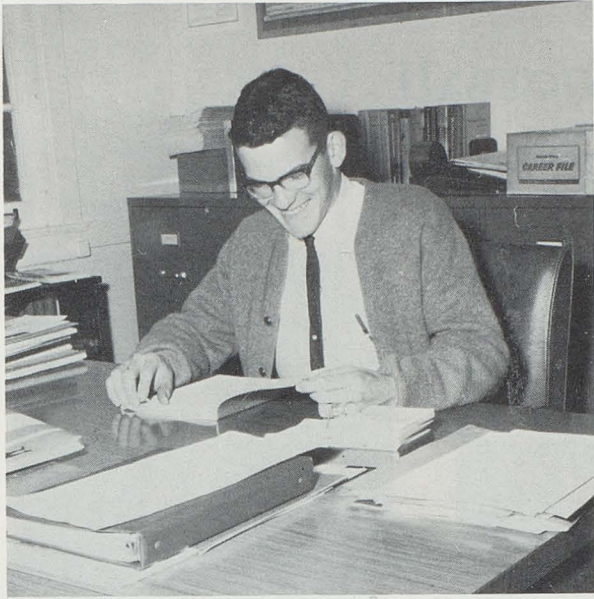


The cooperation that you, the students, have given this year assured many accomplishments which will effect the community and the school. A few examples are:

## CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF

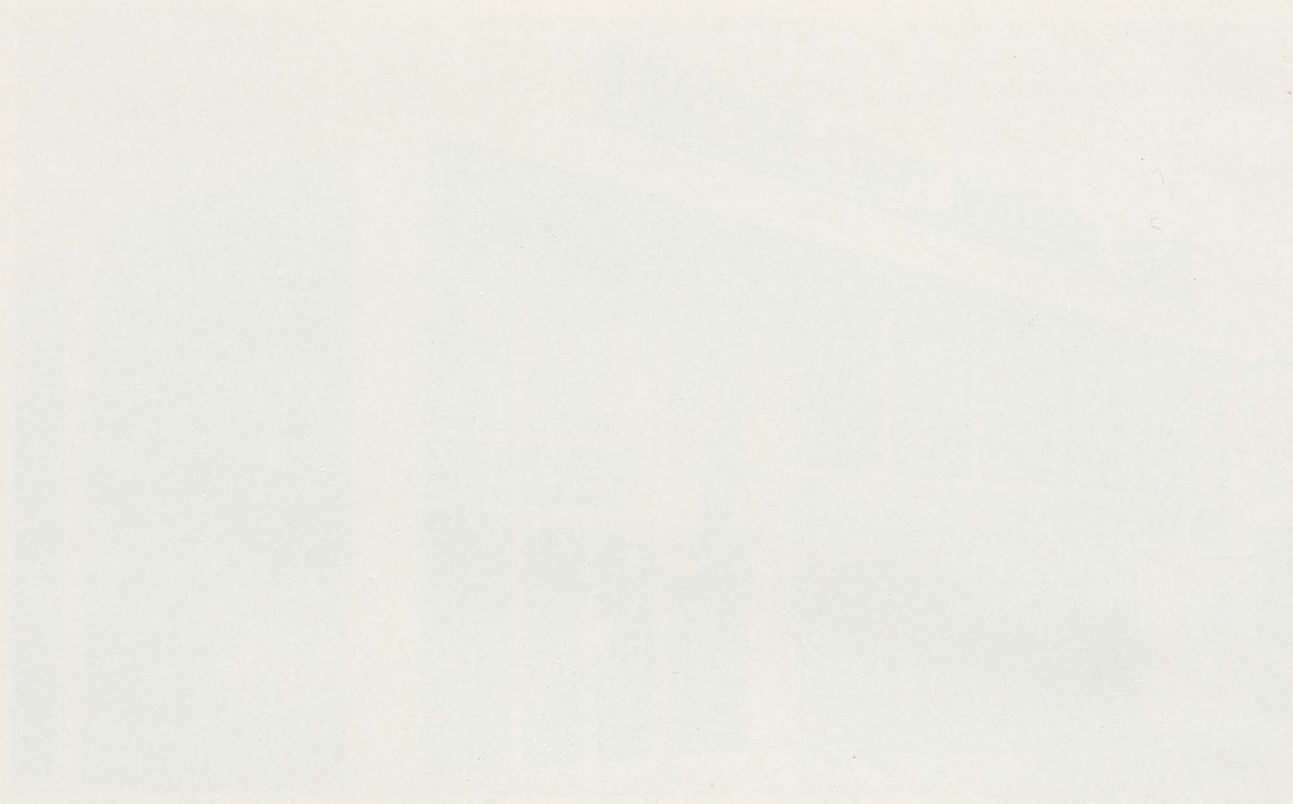
### ARTICLE I

SECTION 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

SECTION 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Senators of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.





## CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF

### ARTICLE I

SECTION 1. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and House of Representatives, which shall be styled the General Assembly. The Senate shall be composed of twenty members, and the House of Representatives of thirty members, to be chosen by the people for the term of two years, and no Representative shall be chosen for more than two terms. The General Assembly shall meet on the first Monday of January in each year, and shall adjourn on the first Monday of March, unless it shall be otherwise ordered by a majority vote of both Houses.

SECTION 2. The Governor shall be elected by the people for the term of four years, and shall hold office until the first Monday of January following the expiration of his term. He shall have the honor and privilege of the floor, and shall preside over the General Assembly. He shall have the power to pardon and commute sentences in all cases except capital crimes, and to grant reprieves and commutations in all cases.
