


You enter a world faced with many problems, overpopulation, rapid changes in technology and one of maybe greatest importance-living together in a world of peace.


What effect will these challenges and many others have on your life? Maybe a more important question to ask is-How well prepared are you to meet these challenges?









The cooperation that you, the students, have given this year assured many accomplishments which will effect the community and the school. A few examples are:


