For the Juniors the door to victory meant a first in skit and sign competition. The Freshman sign told of what the Bearcats meant to them.







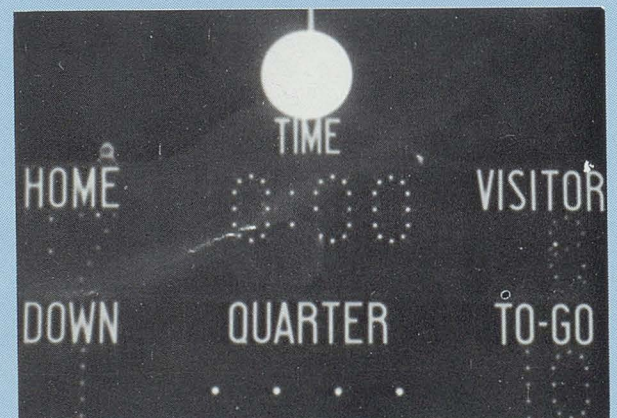
